SPECIAL TRAFFIC MEETING

A PUBLIC MEETING WILL BE HELD ON FRIDAY 4TH FEBRUARY AT 7PM IN THE SURFCLUB

In Catherine Hill Bay we have a difficult situation. There is only one narrow road that runs through the town. This road cannot be widened to accommodate more traffic.

Peter Mc Murray from the Lake Macquarie City Council and Sergeant Steve McBeath from Police Highway Patrol have agreed to attend this meeting. So your concerns will be heard by the right people!

I have attached the latest traffic advice from Samsa Consulting that will form part of the Progress Association's submission to the Department of Planning on the Rose group proposed subdivision. This traffic assessment will inform you as to the impact that the development proposals from Coal & Allied and Rose group will have, if approved, on our town.

REMINDER: SUBMISSIONS REGARDING THE ROSE GROUP PROPOSED SUBDIVISION HAVE TO BE RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING BEFORE MONDAY 7TH FEBRUARY.

The Association is aware that so far approx. 2,000 objections have been sent in. Most of these have been form letters so it is a good idea to add a few thoughts of your own to your submission. A form letter is attached if you wish to use it.

On the 21st January, 10,000 'Save Catho' letters were delivered to homes from Charlestown to Swansea/ Caves Beach. This was initiated by a supporter who loves Catho and does not want to see it destroyed by overdevelopment.
