# Next meeting: 5.00 pm Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> January 2018 at the Community Hall and Bowling Club

Events of the last few months have meant that the Association needs to consider the following significant changes.

- 1. A new developer in our town
- 2. The potential increase in our membership of hundreds of new residents.
- 3. The adoption of a new constitution.

The Association is facing new problems:

The proposals by the developer, Wallalong Lands Pty Ltd, are such that if successful it would in all likelihood lead to the de-listing of Catherine Hill Bay as a State Heritage listed town. This listing, achieved after many years of work, is one of our greatest defences in stopping further overdevelopment within our town.

The executive consists of a small group of volunteers. If we have hundreds of new members then we simply could not deal with all that this entails without employing someone to take the increased workload on full time. The Association does not have the financial resources to do so.

Importantly, we could also be outnumbered in a vote to support changes in the town that do not align with our policy position. Whilst it is true that a motion cannot proceed if it does not align with our policy position there is nothing to stop this policy position being altered in the future by a majority vote.

Following legal advice the executive is proposing the following motions to be considered at the next Association meeting in January:

1) That the objects of the CHB PA Constitution be reworded to:

The objects of the Association are to work for the protection and advancement of the Catherine Hill Bay **Heritage Precinct** community and environment.

2) That item 2(b) of the CHB PA Constitution outlining eligibility for membership be reworded to:

The person is a property owner in Catherine Hill Bay Heritage Precinct, or who is a resident of the Precinct who is not a property owner but has residence for longer than three months.
