I DON'T ACCEPT THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

1. Catho is a unique heritage village on the east coast, there is nothing else like it.
2. Building on coastal headlands is bad planning.
3. Catho is a loved destination for surfers, divers, fishermen and tourists. They go there for what Catho doesn't have - not what it does have.
4. Why destroy such a beautiful place? We should be redeveloping the developed areas, not destroying a unique coastal village.
5. Everywhere else has been spoilt, leave this alone.
6. Any new development should be less than 300 houses that can't be seen from the villages or the sea. (600 of the proposed new houses are overlooking Moonee Beach, where there are currently no houses).
